## Hillsborough County Schedule Change Policy

- Valid reasons for a schedule change may include: counselor or computer error, failing a required course, passing a course in summer or night school, lacking a grad requirement, and lacking proper prerequisite.
- Elective changes cannot be honored due to teacher unit allocation.
- Schedule change requests will not be considered for the purpose of teacher preference.
- A change request may require the entire schedule to be altered, including teachers and periods.
- Once a schedule has been changed, it cannot be changed back to the original schedule.
- Failure to complete summer reading does not constitute a valid reason for a schedule change.
