Purpose: This scholarship is to reward and encourage high school seniors who are residents of the Bloomingtondale community to pursue a college career and to honor the exemplary efforts and outstanding dedication of the late B.J. Stelter, Bloomingtondale Senior High School (BSHS) Principal for 16 years.

Awards: One award is given to a pending graduate of the current school year. It is non-renewable.

Eligibility Requirements:

- ❖ Candidate's parent/guardian must be a resident of Bloomingtondale, as defined on the Bloomingtondale Neighborhood Association website:
www.Bloomingtondale.Life
- ❖ Proof of residency requirement is required before scholarship disbursement.
- ❖ Candidate's parent/guardian must be a member of the Bloomingtondale Neighborhood Association in good standing. Membership must be current when the submission of an application occurs.
- ❖ Candidate must be a graduating high school senior from the Bloomingtondale Community.
- ❖ Candidate must have, according to the latest available Progress Report, at least a weighted 3.2 grade point average. Proof of grade point average will be required before disbursement.
- ❖ Candidate must be accepted at a 2 or 4 year accredited college or university. Students may apply for a scholarship prior to acceptance, but proof of acceptance will be required before scholarship disbursement.
- ❖ The award will be made without regard to financial need.
- ❖ Children or grandchildren of current Bloomingtondale Neighborhood Association Directors or Staff are not eligible.

Selection Criteria: Recipients will be chosen based on the following selection criteria, listed from most important to least important:

- ❖ Community Service
- ❖ Extra-curricular activities
- ❖ Essay
- ❖ Academics
- ❖ Letter (s) of Reference

Important Dates:

- ❖ February 1
 - Scholarship opportunity posted in the Gazette, Facebook and at BSHS. Applicants may attend other schools as long as they live in Bloomingdale.
 - Applications are available at BSHS, via email at bl.neighbor1@gmail.com and on the BNA website at www.Bloomingdale.Life.
 - Applicants with questions may call 813-681-2051 for information.
- ❖ April 1
 - Deadline for applications. No exceptions.
- ❖ April 23 - Bloomingdale Neighborhood Association board meeting.
 - Winner will be invited to attend this meeting and his/her name will be announced.

Essay: Each candidate will complete a **typed** essay of no more than 500 words. The student must select one of the following topics for his essay:

- “What receiving this scholarship would mean to me”
- “What performing Community Service has meant to me”
- “How living and growing up in Bloomingdale has shaped me as a person”

Submission Each candidate will be required to submit the following by the above defined deadline:

- A completed application
- The typed essay
- One letter of reference from a high school faculty member, or, a representative of a Community Service organization listed on the application. While either is acceptable, the latter is preferable.
- An official transcript from their high school.
