For Adult/ESOL students only
- 4. PERSONAL ESSAY**

Be sure to include your career goals, educational goals, family hardships, any extraordinary situations in your life, hobbies, interests, extracurricular activities, community service, and why it is important for you to receive this scholarship. As part of your essay we would like to know your support system: academic, financial, and emotional. Essay should be typed and double spaced.
- 5. PERSONAL REFERENCES/RECOMMENDATION LETTERS**
Two (2) letters are required, typed and double spaced:
 - One recommendation letter must be from a school faculty/staff member. Please include attendance, cooperativeness, and interest in CTE/career path.

- One recommendation letter must be from a community member (non-relative) such as clergy, employer, neighbor, etc. Please include specific activities of the applicant
