

Bloomingdale PTSA Scholarship Award



The Bloomingdale PTSA Scholarship Award was established by the Bloomingdale PTSA to honor a graduating seniors at Bloomingdale High School who demonstrate a positive attitude toward scholarship, leadership and commitment to community service. The amount of the award is \$500 which will be awarded at the Senior awards night in May.

Eligibility requirements:

- 1. GPA of 3.0 or higher (Unweighted);
- 2. Bloomingdale senior student graduating in 2018 from Bloomingdale High School who will attend an accredited four year or two year college or university or trade school (proof of acceptance required).
- 3. Demonstrated leadership abilities in school, through club membership, community service or other extracurricular activities OR overcame challenges or obstacles during their high school years at Bloomingdale High School.

Applications are due to Mrs. Edgeman, Bloomingdale Guidance Counselor, no later than April 20 2018. In order to be considered, parent/guardian or student must be a PTSA member by April 20, 2018. Membership can be submitted with the application. Please go to http://bloomingdaleptsa.org/ to print the membership form. The award recipients will be notified of the scholarship at the Bloomingdale Senior Awards Night in April at Bloomingdale High School. The check will be written directly to the college/university/trade school the student will attend.
