ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- The candidate's parent or guardian must be a resident of the Greater Brandon area as defined by the geographic area identified herein as "Brandon" includes the area bounded by the FishHawk subdivision to the south, Interstate 4 to the north, Turkey Creek Road to the east, and US Highway 301 to the west.
- Proof of residency will be required with this application
- Candidates must be a graduating high school senior
- Candidate must have at least a weighted 3.0 grade point average, proof provided with this application
- Candidate must be accepted at a 2 or 4 year accredited college or university, proof provided with application
- The award will be made without regard to financial need
