## **Eligibility Requirement(s):**

- The Contest is open to all college-bound, high school seniors who submit an essay application through a Chapter of the Fraternity.
- The essay must be original and neither previously published nor secured by copyright. The essay must be between 700
  and 750 words in length. The type-written, double-spaced essay may be submitted via postal service or email in
  Microsoft Word.

## **Administration of Scholarship Fund**

Our organization will award three checks to our selected essay winners. The breakdown is as follows:

1<sup>st</sup>: \$750.00 2<sup>nd</sup>: \$500.00 3<sup>rd</sup>: \$250.00

The top essay (1st Place) will also be submitted to compete in the Fraternity's International Essay Contest. Four College Scholarships will be awarded. The amounts are as follows:

1st: \$5,000.00 2nd: \$3,000.00 3rd: \$2,000.00 4th: \$1,000.00
