# 2022-2023 Scholarships

## Applications now available.

The scholarship season is now open. Applications are being accepted and must be postmarked prior to April 30, 2023. The Department of Florida AMVETS Scholarship Committee members and Service Foundation look forward to receiving and reviewing your scholarship package(s). Do not hesitate to ask any questions related to your application submittal(s).

When submitting for an AMVETS scholarship, make sure the letter is free of both grammatical and spelling errors. Students are an important part of the AMVETS voting process and the literacy demonstrated in a scholarship package is a reflection of the student.

There are three categories of the Department of Florida AMVETS scholarships to be awarded in June 2023. They are:

- Donald P. Rhindress JROTC scholarship: candidates must have at least 2-years of JROTC participation, maintain a minimum 3.0 or higher school GPA, participate in high school sponsored extra-curricular activities, participate in community service, and maintain a military appearance/demeanor while in the JROTC uniform.
- General scholarship: candidates will have completed, at a minimum, their first year of an accredited university, must be a member of the Department of Florida AMVETS, or the son/daughter or grandchild of a member of the Department of Florida AMVETS.
- Joseph L Kee Scholarship: candidate is a high school senior scheduled to graduate from high school during 2023 that has maintained a minimum 3.0 or higher school GPA, participate in high school sponsored extra-curricular activities, participate in community service, and is a son/daughter, grandchild or great grandchild of a member of the Department of Florida AMVETS. This scholarship is reviewed and awarded by the AMVETS Department of Florida Service Foundation.
