Scholarship Guidelines

PURPOSE: Our scholarships are meant to help students who are seeking degrees in environmentally related fields of study. Such as: Renewable Energy, Clean Energy, Geothermal Energy, Bio Molecular Engineering, Bio Systems/Engineering & Soil Science, Environmental/ Earth Science, Ecology, Horticulture, Civil and Environmental Engineering, Ecology /Natural Resources Conservation, Environmental Sustainability, Agricultural Education, Botany, Aquaculture/Marine Biology

STANDARDS: Merit consistent with academic achievement is the predominant selection criteria. Consideration should also include community involvement, commitment to career, and financial need.

AMOUNT: Scholarship funds are dependent on the club's annual budget and are directly related to the success of our annual Plant/Rummage sale as well as other fund raising activities throughout the year. The committee, we will select (2) seniors scheduled to graduate in 2019. Each will receive a \$ 2,500.00 scholarship written out to college of acceptance.

ELIGIBILITY: Applicants must be enrolled in afore mentioned studies: environmental horticulture, natural resources conservation, environmental sustainability, or agricultural education. He /she must have a GPA of (3) or above.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE: The application and selection of representatives from each school will be handled by the high school Guidance Departments in accordance with our club guidelines (see below).

The Deadline is April 15, 2019. The recipient should be willing to attend our **June 12, 2019** meeting for the presentation ceremony. Our club will handle all arrangements for newspaper coverage/and club newsletter. The recipient/s will be presented a check made out to the college he/she has been accepted by.
