

Virtual School – Creating an Account & Registering for a Class

1. Using Chrome, go to www.flvs.net
2. From the homepage, click on “Enroll” in the top right corner



3. In the pop-up window, click on “Grades 6-12” next to “County Virtual School”


5. Next, click “New Students Start Here”



6. Next, choose Florida, Hillsborough County, and Public School Student, then click “Continue”



7. The next page is where you select your class(es). You can use the filters on the left to narrow down the list to just high school classes or to look at specific subjects.
8. Hover over the class you want to request and click “Select”



9. Choose the semester you'd like to sign up for (semester 1, semester 2, or full year)

Think of a segment as a traditional semester, or 16-18 weeks. At FLVS, you move at your own pace, so a segment may take you 8 weeks or 24 weeks. Two segments equal a full year of any course.

Students are placed as quickly as possible according to their requested start date. At certain times of the year, there may be a slight delay due to high volume requests. Now that you have chosen the course(s) you want, let's create your account and start the sign-up process! In this step, you will need to know some key information like your address, phone number, social security number and parent/guardian contact info.

15. Fill in the blanks to set up the student username and password. There will be several more pages where you’ll enter parent information, select Bloomingdale as your school, and select your counselor.

16. Once your account is created, you’ll submit your course request, and your counselor will approve your course.

17. You’ll get assigned a teacher around the start date you selected. That teacher will send a message to your virtual account with their information. You’ll call the teacher and they’ll explain how the class works (were to find assignments, how to submit work, etc.). Once you’ve done the welcome call, you’ll be activated and can work through the class. Once you complete the class, virtual school will send the grade to Bloomingdale and it will be added to your transcript.
